



# KINDERGARTEN IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

4 POLIO

5 DTP

2 MMR

3 HEPATITIS B

1 VARICELLA (CHICKEN POX)

MANTOUX TB TEST

**Note:**

3 Polio meets the requirements if the 3rd Polio was given on or after the 4th birthday.

4 DTP meets the requirement if the 4th DTP was given on or after the 4th birthday.

1 Measles only + 1 MMR meets the requirement if both were given on or after the 1st birthday.

History of Chicken Pox disease, documented on record by physician, meets the Varicella requirement.

Mantoux TB Test must be within 1 year of starting Kindergarten.

Physical Exam: A physical examination is required of all Kindergarten and 1st grade enrollees. A doctor or health Clinic must complete an orange card form. A comprehensive physical examination and health assessment consistent with Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHOP) guidelines is required for all first grade students within 18 months prior to entry or up to 3 months after admission to the first grade.

As with all California immunization requirements, children can be admitted as long as they have begun a vaccine series and the next dose is not yet due, even if the series has not been completed. However, they must get the remaining doses in the series as they become due or they will be excluded from school.

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
